Sports in the community. Barrier to information being sent out from the school to parents and pupils in primary and lower secondary. Used to be a termly Active Schools email. Many are vitally important. Active Schools Coordinator not allowed to use Groupcall. Same at Pitlochry. Active Schools Coordinator would collate this and send it out so it's not too regular. Told to add to website. But most people don't know about this and can't find it. Action — get a list of termly clubs and activities and find out how we can publicise them. could a school email it to all parents?

Mairi has a proposal to seek wider funding for swimming. Need some evidence of how this can benefit pupils. Seeking funding to run pilot. Live Active have provided cost per teacher and pool hire. Target P1, P2 & P3. 1 lessons per week for (three) terms. £3,500CIV fund. Limited amount left in pot. Mairi to apply to Jimmy Cairncross Charitable Trust. Jane — would like to see this applied in secondary.

John Duff — There is £60,000 in the Council budget for swimming lessons but £30,000 of that is for travel costs getting the pupils to the pool. This year's CIF is closed but there is another pot of CIF money approved today which will probably open for applications in 2-3 months. Motion carried to support this.
